

THE WORLD CLASS TEJAS BULLFIGHT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

*Sponsored by Texas Bullfights, LLC.
Administered by the Fort Bend Partnership for Youth,
a 501(c)3 non-profit organization, and the
Fort Bend County Juvenile Probation Department.*

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM OVERVIEW

As a result of the inaugural event, **World Class Tejas Bullfights**, held July 5, 2008, Texas Bullfights, LLC (dba Tejas Bullfights), whose mission in part is to provide scholarships for youth, gave \$10,000 to the Fort Bend Partnership for Youth to administer and distribute. These funds will be used to provide scholarships for eligible Fort Bend youth wishing to pursue higher education but who lack the financial means to do so.

The desire of the 2 promoters, William Carter and Don Dulin, is to provide these scholarships to youth who wish to further their education by learning a trade or attending college. It is proposed that the scholarships be provided utilizing the existing Fort Bend Partnership for Youth nonprofit organization with the below qualifications.

SCHOLARSHIP QUALIFICATIONS:

Candidates must be a high school senior and graduate by the current spring semester or enrolled in a GED program with a projected completion date no later than the end of July. In the initial year, it is proposed that five (5) \$1,000.00 scholarships be provided for the Fall 2009 semester, payable directly to the school, in increments of \$500.00 per semester as long as the student adheres to the conditions listed below in items numbered 7 and 8.

1. The World Class Tejas Bullfight Scholarship Programs will present a limited number of Open and Vocational scholarships. These scholarships will be awarded with no restrictions regarding the course of study. The student must be pursuing a certificate from a recognized institution that prepares a student for a minimum of semi-professional or technical employment. A course outline for the certification must be presented with proof of registration. Students may be enrolling in a vocational school, technical school, cosmetology or hair stylist school, a junior college or a 4 year college.
2. Selection of the recipient will be based primarily on socio-economic needs and a desire to improve their lives. Secondly the applicants will be judged on scholastic standing, leadership, citizenship, and course of study. Involvement in the juvenile justice system is not a requirement or a factor in determining the scholarship recipient.
3. The Fort Bend Partnership For Youth and the Fort Bend County Juvenile Probation Department Scholarship Committee will be responsible for appointing a committee of at least seven (7) persons to select the winners consisting of two (2) individuals designated by the principals of World Class Tejas Bullfights, two (2) Fort Bend County juvenile probation officers designated by the Chief Juvenile Probation Officer and three (3) individuals designated by the Fort Bend Partnership for Youth.

4. Applicants are required to list any other scholarships received or applied for at the time of application for the World Class Tejas Bullfight Scholarship.
5. Students who have completed a prior scholarship from the World Class Tejas Bullfight Scholarship may reapply for another scholarship. No more than 2 scholarships will be awarded to a student.
6. Final approval of each scholarship winner will be made by the management team of the Fort Bend County Juvenile Probation Department.
7. The recipient, other than vocational, must be enrolled as a full-time student and taking twelve (12) hours or more per semester in a college, university or junior college. Vocational scholarship recipients must be enrolled in a vocational school, technical school, cosmetology or hair stylist school and present a course outline to the scholarship selection panel prior to any funds being disbursed.
8. The funds will be disbursed directly to the learning institution in the following manner. A \$500 check to be paid each fall/spring semester for one year upon receipt of a copy of the transcript, the enrollment schedule for the upcoming semester and the student having maintained a 2.0 grade point per semester. Transcript and enrollment schedule must have student's name, college and number of hours. Scholarship will begin the fall semester following receipt of scholarship. Vocational recipients must demonstrate good standing in their course of study.
9. Scholarship recipients are required to submit a recent (3 x 5 bust) glossy photo and a completed achievement form upon notification. Do not send photo with application.
10. Recipients are required to attend the scholarship awards presentation unless approved by written authorization from a Fort Bend Partnership for Youth official..
- 11. DO NOT ALTER, ADD PAGES, ADD RESUMES OR WRITE ON BACK OF THE APPLICATION.**
12. NARRATIVE: Each applicant must include a typed narrative of no more than two 8 ½" X 11" sheets, double-spaced. Applicant may supply any information he/she feels is pertinent to the application.
